EMBLEM

On a light blue disc edged Air Force blue two white elongated stylized missile shapes vertically placed between on the emblem's right and left two stylized yellow decoy missiles and within the center two more of the same one above the other all outlined Air Force blue. Below the disc a blank white scroll edged Air Force blue. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Light blue and white have been

chosen by this squadron and Air Force blue and Air Force yellow represent the Air Force, while the six stylized missiles depicted are indicative of the weapons and the decoy weapons maintained by this unit. (Approved, 19 Feb 1964) Idea by Maj George E. Daniel, Developed by A2C David W. Gibson
