Aircraft Phaseouts. The last operational flight of a USAF B-29 aircraft ended at 2010 on 21 June when RB-29-15-MO landed at Naha Air Base, Okinawa, after completing a routine mission. Four 6023d Radar Evaluation Squadron RB-29s flew electronic countermeasure training for a number of years. All four aircraft were salvaged on 30 June. In addition, the last of PACAF's once numerous fleet of C-119 Hying Boxcars departed. Eight of the aircraft were transferred to India under the Military Assistance Program 1960
