### **EMBLEM**

On a blue disc a yellow sun, rayant, to the right and behind a light blue demiglobe, grid lined

yellow issuing from base and supporting a gray paladin; all within a narrow yellow border. Attached above and below the disc blank blue scrolls edged with a narrow yellow border. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Blue and yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The paladin symbolizes the Electronic Security Command and represents mobility and flexibility in mission accomplishment. The globe reflects the worldwide mission area available to the 6945th.
