Providing computer software to meet the increasing demand for automation support for the worldwide mission of the Electronic Security Command is the job of the 6964th Communications-Computer Systems Squadron.

Located in ESC headquarters at Kelly AFB, the 6964th is a direct reporting unit to the deputy chief of staff for Communications-Computer Systems.

The unit supports the entire command and is involved in all aspects of ESC's missions. They provide communications and computer systems software expertise and direct support to staff agencies, ESC field units and other non-ESC organizations such as the Joint Electronic Warfare Center and the Joint Tactical Command and Control Communications Agency.

Squadron personnel provide the know-how and skills needed to ensure that all of the command's computer software needs are satisfied, including satisfaction of national level agency requirements. They also assist with developing and implementing communications-computer policies, objectives and plans.

Recent initiatives by the 6964th include overseeing the installation of the Constant Web system at the headquarters and installation of the management support systems phase-two software at the field units. These systems are only two examples of the many major advances in providing automation support to the diverse missions of the ESC.

In order to provide the increased support of the mission demands, the unit is continuing it's education

in areas of software engineering, quality management and advanced technologies. This will keep ESC at the forefront of changes in communications-computer software technologies to ensure that the ESC mission is accomplished through the year 2000 and beyond with quality and excellence.
