OPERATIONS

Contract aircraft maintenance was performed by two companies at Paris-Orly. Air France and TAI-Transports Aeriens Intercontinentaux supported transient VIP aircraft and provided periodic inspections on 7415th aircraft. This contract maintenance reduced USAF manning needs at Orly AB. The 7415th Food Service section was always busy, preparing 4,600 inflight meals per month for passengers on outbound military flights as well as operating the base mess hall for unit and transient personnel.

On 25 September 1957, the 7415th Air Base Group was redesignated the 7415th Support Group at Orly AB with no changes in mission. Personnel strength was increased a small amount to a total of 703 officers, airmen, DAF civilians and French workers. Its seven squadrons were reduced to four. These units were Headquarters, 7415th Support Group; 7415th Support Squadron; 7415th Material Squadron; and 7415th USAF Dispensary.
