OPERATIONS

If there is any organization situated at the heart of running the small city that is McClellan Air Force Base, it is "CE"--the 77th Civil Engineer Group. The group consists of a diverse population comprised of over 500 professionals: licensed engineers, firefighters, planners, disaster

preparedness specialists, computer programmers, financial managers, housing and real estate specialists, and construction trades craftsmen. 77 CEG is responsible for operating and maintaining the \$ 3.1 billion worth of infrastructure and facilities on base: 3,797 acres of land, nine separate operating locations, 12.7 million square feet of facilities, 4.6 million square yards of pavement, and the base's utilities networks. Through design work, construction, repair, maintenance, disaster preparedness, environmental management, fire protection, 1 and more, 77 CEG professionals sustain virtually the entire depot operation at Sacramento Air Logistics Center. As the base approaches closure, much of this work will be assumed by Sacramento County contractors under a cooperative agreement transfer of the base's operating infrastructure. Still, McClellan Air Force Base could not be run without 77 CEG. Col Thomas Hayden
