## **EMBLEM**



Ultramarine Blue and Golden Yellow are the Air Force Colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow symbolizes the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The pyramid indicates solid foundation and strength of purpose. The sword symbolizes justice and enforcement of the law. The olive branch over the sword signifies enforcement of the law with dignity and restraint. The eye refers to the squadron motto, Ever

The 2750th Security Police Squadron and its 67 members were assigned to Wright-Patterson AFB, Ohio, and given the mission of providing security police support to the installation. At the time of activation, the unit's orderly room functions were performed by the Headquarters Squadron Section, 2750th Air Base Wing. This changed on 1 April 1981 when the Security Police Orderly room was activated in Building 168, Area C, and granted responsibility for managing the military personnel assigned to the squadron.
