## OPERATIONS

Six new units come under the Alamo Wing following a reorganization of Air Force Reserve management structure in October. The addition increased the strength by approximately 75 officers and 560 airmen. The Kelly based units included the 32nd Aeromedical Evacuation Group, 74th and 75th Mobile Aerial Port Squadrons, 96th Maintenance and 96th Supply Squadron. The 96th was assigned to the 433d , but worked for the San Antonio Air Logistic Center (ALC). Also

assigned was the Fourth Air Logistics Center Augmentation Squadron, Harlingen, Texas. AFRES announced the change concurrent with the inactivation of AFRES regions and the activation of the Fourth, Tenth and Fourteenth Air Forces (Reserve). November marked the first time the units met in support of the Alamo Wing.
