Constituted in the Regular Army on 8 May 1929 as the 97th Attack Squadron, assigned to the 33rd Attack Group and allotted to the Eighth Corps Area. Organized on 23 August 1935 with Organized Reserve personnel as a RAI unit at Fort Crockett, TX. Withdrawn from the Eighth Corps Area on 5 June 1936 and allotted to the Sixth Corps Area. Inactivated on 31 October 1936 at Fort Crockett by relief of Reserve personnel. Chicago, IL, designated as headquarters location on organization, but the unit was never reorganized at that location. Demobilized on 1 January 1938.
