OPERATIONS

On June 6, authorization for 50 officers was granted. they attempted to reassign as many individuals as possible from the 8594th to the 482d Fighter Bomber Wing as a step to bring the strength of the 8594th down to authorized limitations. This was accomplished through careful screening of records and reclassification. The completion of some assignments during this reorganization was hampered due to the reservists being on active duty only one weekend each month. This problem was alleviated by communication with the personnel concerned at their homes and places of business. The necessary coordination was then completed and the strength of the 8594th Replacement Training Squadron was reduced to 83 officers and 25 airmen by 30 June 1955.

The 8594th is comprised of Detachments "A", "B" and "C" with units A and B made up of rated personnel and unit C being all non-rated personnel.
