During the early 1960s, Keesler lost many of its airborne training courses and the aircraft they required. The TC-54s assigned to electronic warfare officer training departed to Mather AFB, California, in April 1961. In December 1962, the Air Ground Operations School and its T-33s

transferred to Eglin AFB, Florida; and the last C-47 used for ground approach radar training left in 1966, when it was replaced by an earth bound simulator.
