

# **100<sup>th</sup> SERVICE SQUADRON**

100th Service Squadron (G.H.Q.A.F.)  
HQ-Bolling Field, DC, 1935-36

Constituted in the Regular Army on 1 March 1935, assigned to the General Headquarters Air Force, and organized at Bolling Field, DC. Consolidated in 1935 with the 100th Aero Squadron (a WWI unit organized on 22 August 1917 at Kelly Field, TX; demobilized on 13 June 1919 at Mitchel Field, NY; reconstituted in 1935). Consolidated with the Station Complement, Bolling Field and consolidated unit redesignated Base Headquarters and 14th Air Base Squadron on 1 September 1936.
