

944th MISSION SUPPORT SQUADRON

12 Dec 1941, Air Service Command established four Air Service Area Commands in the United States. By about mid-1942 the Ogden Air Depot came under control of the IV with headquarters at Sacramento, California.

Air Service Command's abolishment of its four Air Service Area Commands resulted in Ogden Air Depot attaining its first command status as the Ogden Air Depot Control Area Command. Its mission was: maintenance, repair, overhaul service and supply within these states: Washington, Oregon, Nevada, Idaho, Utah and western Montana. The new command established these staff Sections: Engineer (later Office of Engineer and forerunner of present Civil Engineering), Adjutant General, Budget and Fiscal, Chaplain, Control Office (forerunner of the Comptroller), Intelligence which included Public Relations and Provost Marshal operational elements, Chemical (effective 19 February 1943 to supply equipment and supervise chemical warfare training), Ogden Statistical Control, Staff Judge Advocate and these Divisions: Personnel and Training, Maintenance and Supply., 1 Feb 1943
