

From 1942 to about March 1943, flying training squadrons were assigned directly to the regional training command and attached to the school at the base where they were located. In 1943, the AAF formed flying training groups and reassigned the remaining squadrons to the groups. The same happened to Technical School Squadrons in Feb 43. Group headquarters were not newly constituted, except for some [Technical] Training Groups. Instead, one of the squadrons on a base was redesignated as a training group headquarters. The following gaps are due to these redesignation. Undoubtedly more of the gaps are as well, but my list is not complete.

Today they may be called Technical Training Squadrons, but in 1942, they were called Technical School Squadrons. In 1942, what had been School Squadrons were redesignated as Technical School Squadrons if they were assigned to AAF Technical Training Command, or various types of Flying Training Squadrons if they were assigned to AAF Flying Training Cd.
