EMBLEM

On a disc Azure, a globe in base Celeste, gridlined Or, surmounted overall by a stylized eagle, wings displayed descending in bend to dexter base Gules, fimbriated and detailed Argent, all within a narrow border Black. Attached above the disc, a Yellow scroll edged with a narrow

Black border and inscribed "NOT FOR SELF BUT FOR OTHERS" in Black letters. Attached below the disc, a Yellow scroll edged with a narrow Black border and inscribed "151 OPERATIONS SUPPORT FLIGHT" in Black letters. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The eagle represents the patriotism of unit members in the service of their country. The globe represents the Flight's global mission. The motto, "Not for Self but for Others," reminds unit members that it is only through their service that others may accomplish their mission.
