Headquarters 154th Support Group is one of four major organizations of the 154th Wing. Located at Hickam AFB, HI, the group provides management and direction to five assigned units. The unit has a federal and state mission. The federal mission is to provide trained units and qualified individuals to be available for active duty in the Air Force in time of war, national emergency, or times as national security may require. The state mission is to defend the State of Hawaii and its people from mass violence, originating from either human or natural causes.

The Group was federally recognized on 31 Oct 1994 and is assigned five subordinate units: the 154th Civil Engineer Squadron, the 154th Security Police Squadron, the 154th Communications flight, the 154th Service flight, and the 154th Mission Support Flight.
