In 1995, Air National Guard aircraft maintenance units were reorganized in conjunction with the Air Force objective structure. The purpose of this reorganization is to streamline operations and procedures, and to provide for the reserve components' smooth transition to the active duty structure if mobilized.

The AGS is organized into Sortie Generation (Flight Line) and Sortie Support (Inspection Dock) Flights. The AGS is responsible for the launch, service, on-equipment repair, inspection, and recovery of the Wing's assigned aircraft.
