Operational functions within the squadron include the Military Personnel Flight, Education and Training Flight, and Career Assistance Advisor. The squadron also trains deployable personnel to support contingency operations. The squadron directly supports the wing's most important resource, our people. Subordinate to the group are three flights and three squadrons.

The 166 Mission Support Group manages people and resources in support of the war fighter to ensure that all personnel are ready and able to deploy in support of contingencies and exercises anywhere in the world.
