The 1 Aeromedical Transport Group was assigned the domestic aeromedical evacuation mission. The group operated the 10 Aeromedical Transport Squadron, Kelly AFB; 11 Aeromedical Transport Squadron, Scott AFB; 12 Aeromedical Transport Squadron, McGuire AFB; 13 Aeromedical Transport Squadron, Travis AFB; 14 Aeromedical Transport Squadron, Brooks AFB; and the 15 Aeromedical Transport Squadron, Brookley AFB. Squadrons primarily operated the C-131s and C-118s.
