Constituted in the Regular Army on 8 May 1929 as Headquarters, 4th Pursuit Wing and allotted to the Eighth Corps Area. Kelly Field, TX, designated as headquarters on organization, but the unit was never organized at that location. Designated mobilization training station was the Air Corps Training Center, Kelly Field. Withdrawn from the Eighth Corps Area on 1 October 1933

and allotted to the Fourth Corps Area. Redesignated as Headquarters and Headquarters Squadron, 4th Pursuit Wing on 1 September 1936.
